The shaded area above is flexible scheduling. Assignments are required 2 or 3 times per week. You choose the nights.

\* Study math facts and the Wordly Wise book at least 5 minutes 3 or more times a week. Please check the box and initial on the night your child completes the assignment.

\*\* The Phonics Reader comes home on Monday. It needs to be read 2 times that week to build fluency.

Read 5 nights a week for at least 20 minutes. Your child should be reading AR books at home. October 1, we start reading 30 minutes a day. If your child is struggling and you see he/she cannot finish in 20 minutes, you may read to your child. We are requiring 10 points for AR this quarter. Next quarter your child's goal will be based on the STAR testing score. We will share that with you at conference time.
